Precinct 69 - Waitman Barbe School, hand tallying was completed at 4:10 P.M.

Let the record show that the results of the hand tally of Precinct 69 - Waitman Barbe Elementary School, compared to the scanner results was within the one (1\%) percent as per West Virginia Code.

The Tally Clerks left at 4:10 P.M.

Let the record show at $4: 15$ P.M. the Board of Canvassers began reviewing the nine hundred forty-two (942) Challenge Ballots for allowing or disallowing as permitted by law.

Precinct Number 1 - Sixteen (16) Challenged Ballots - Motion by Commissioner Pyles, seconded by Commissioner Wiley, and unanimously carried, to allow ten (10) ballots and to disallow six (6) ballots because four (4) voters voted in the wrong precinct and two (2) voters were not registered to vote.

Precinct Number 2 - Five (5) Challenged Ballot - Motion by Commissioner Pyles, seconded by Commissioner Wiley, and unanimously carried, to allow three (3) ballots and to disallow two (2) ballots because the two (2) voters were not registered to vote.
